Lesson 10 – Examination Primer II



The Examination Primer II is a cloud-based software program that enables you to test your knowledge of the Social Security disability process. This tool was specifically designed to help professional advocates prepare for SSA direct-pay examination.

Access - You access the Exam Primer using the same link and access code as your prep course.

Account - Each Primer account comes with 6 quizzes, 2 full exams and 1 essay test.

Once inside the Primer, you'll note three boxes marked Add Quiz, Exam or Essay. These buttons enable you to add additional tests to your account if you desire.

Certification Prep Test - Clicking on this dropdown will expose your available quizzes, exams and essays. Each time you start a test, it is deducted from your test total. Once a test begins, it cannot be cancelled. If you have problems with a test, contact us at stussa@daincpm.net.

Upon completion of a test, you will be given the score and feedback for incorrect answers.

This feedback may also include links to SSA reference materials related to the test question.

Account Information - This segment contains your basic account information and it enables you to change your account password.

To the right, you'll see a list of green buttons. These buttons enable you to take subject focused quizzes. For example, you'd like to test your knowledge of Medical Issues. Clicking medical issues will enable you to take a quiz that focuses on medical issues.
